This individual will help with the coordination of GBRC outreach efforts within the Vietnamese Community and provide translation and on-site translator services. The position will entail a combination of field and office work (both in-person and remote). Vietnamese language proficiency is required. - Provide Vietnamese translation and on-site translator services
- Assist with development, preparation, and data collection for GBRC surveys
