Specific Duties

- Collecting 32-gallon recycling bins containing shucked oyster shells from Clear Lake and Kemah area restaurants with a truck and trailer and transporting them to storage sites in Pasadena and/or Texas City
- Emptying full bins of shell at storage sites according to established protocols
- Assisting with upkeep of shell recycling equipment and equipment storage unit
- Promptly and accurately entering quantitative data associated with oyster shell collection

Qualifications

- **Must have experience and competence driving a full-sized truck and connecting, hauling, and maneuvering a flatbed trailer up to 16 feet long**
- **Must have a valid driver's license and clean driving record**
- Ability to physically lift up to 100 pounds from ground level to trailer (or truck bed) and pull a rolling recycling bin weighing up to 200 pounds
- Experience with Microsoft Excel for data entry and a commitment to data accuracy and integrity
- Availability on Mondays, Wednesdays, and/or Fridays
